Cohort Studies. Some cohort studies measure mortality, others measure incidence of disease. The incidence rate is defined as the number of NEW cases of a disease divided by the population at risk over a given period of time. In occupational and environmental epidemiology it is important to be able to characterise the exposure of the 'population at risk'.
