The crux of this cyberbullying law case centers on a phony Facebook profile. The page is made to look like Tina controls it and includes childish barbs. For example, the page lists Tina's native language as "Retardish"; it also features a racist video - again, posted under Tina's name.

But now federal case law allows schools to discipline students for off-campus behavior that results in a significant disruption of the school's academic environment. Consequently, many states have made amendments to their laws allowing schools greater opportunities for involvement in putting an end to cyberbullying.

Like the Meier case, the Clementi case spurred legislators (this time, in New Jersey) to pass a law specifically aimed at bullying, an "Anti-bullying Bill of Rights". [20] While some laws are written such that the focus on cyberbullying is the set of acts that occur within a school, others are more general, targeting cyberbullying no matter where it occurs.
