The health care infrastructure in rural areas has been developed as a three tier system as follows. Sub Centre : Most peripheral contact point between Primary Health Care System & Community manned with one HW(F)/ANM & one HW(M) Primary Health Centre (PHC) : A Referral Unit for 6 Sub Centres 4-6 bedded manned with a Medical Officer Incharge and 14 subordinate paramedical staff
