Oils come in three finishes: matte, satin or gloss. They soak into the wood without any surface buildup, resulting in a natural wood-like finish after the necessary six or more coats. Varnish builds up faster with fewer coats and requires a light scuffing between coats. Before coating, the wood must be dry.
