Hospital Patient Discharge Process Best Practices ...

What Is Discharge Planning? Medicare states that discharge planning is “a process used to decide what a patient needs for a smooth move from one level of care to another. ” Only a doctor can authorize a patient’s release from the hospital, but the actual process of discharge planning can be completed by a social worker, nurse, case manager, or other person. Ideally, and especially for the most complicated medical conditions, discharge planning is done with a team approach.

Discharge Planning: A dynamic process requiring collaboration between the patients, their whanau/family and health care team to anticipate and respond to changes in health care needs beyond hospitalisation.

Discharge planning is the joint effort of the patient, family, clinician, and hospital care team on Med/Surg or personnel involved in the patient's plan of care. The patient's clinician may request a social work consult to assist with discharge planning needs and concerns.
