Mature Plants. In the wild, dragon fruit plants can reach a length of 15 to 20 feet. In your garden, they need a good trellis or arbor to support the weight of the vines and fruit. They don't twine, but must be tied to the trellis. They will typically bloom around April of the second spring and fruit matures around 50 days after bloom.

Growing Dragon Fruit From Seed: Sprinkle the seeds onto the surface of the soil and cover with a thin layer of growing medium. Moisten the soil with a spray bottle and cover with plastic wrap to keep moisture. The seed should germinate within 15-30 days. After they've germinated, remove the plastic wrap, and transplant to a bigger pot.

Plant your rooted dragon fruit in the ground, in rich, well-drained soil in light shade. You can also continue to grow the cactus in a pot. In optimal conditions, your cutting grown plants will begin to bear in as little as two years. Water well twice a week to keep soil evenly moist.

To grow dragon fruit from seed, slice a dragon fruit in half and use a spoon to scrape out some seeds. Rinse the seeds. Pulp will cling to the seeds, and it's fine to plant with it attached. Fill a cup or small pot with sterile seed starter or cactus soil mix. Moisten the soil but avoid saturating it with water.
