Step 1: Choose to Publish a New Item or Update an Existing Item. Go to the Home tab on the Storyline ribbon and click Publish. When the Publish window appears, select the Review 360 tab on the left. (If you have an Articulate 360 tab instead of Review 360, update Storyline 360 to see all the latest enhancements.

4 Replies. if you are viewing a published file you can access by selecting the story.html file to run the project. If you want to edit the file in Storyline you will need the source (.story) file which by default won't be part of the published package. You can open published content by double-clicking story.html.

How to View A Published Articulate Storyline File ...

After publishing the project, open a new Articulate Storyline file. In the ribbon we can find Insert tab. On clicking the Insert tab, you can find the Record Screen option. After clicking this dropdown button, you can find Record your screen button. On clicking Record your screen button, you can find the Recording Area panel. You can adjust the panel's width and height to suit your requirement and click the Record button in the panel.

Publish your Articulate course. Create a .zip file of the published course. Drag the .zip file to the Tempshare site. The course is uploaded and you'll get a temporary URL good for a few days. Share the link. Again the link isn't permanent and it can't be overwritten. If you make changes, you'll need to repeat the process.

Upload the files from the course publish folder. Click on upload. Select Files. Use the Browse window to select all files listed in this folder. Alternatively, you may be able to drag and drop the files from your windows explorer view into your SharePoint page. This is dependent on your SharePoint version. Create a new folder entitled story_content.

How to upload an Articulate Storyline course onto ...

Local PC distribution for Articulate courses is much simpler, and unlike the iPad example, it is indeed possible to load and run the courses with no dependency on Internet connection. Since each published course is a collection of files, the files can be simply transferred to a PC or a Mac machine on a CD, flash drive, or any other removable media.
