Unfortunately, modern Jaeger charts are not standardised, and the actual letter sizes on different cards might vary slightly. The type scale on a modern Jaeger eye chart usually ranges from J14 (approximately 14-point type for Times New Roman font) to J1 (approximately 3-point type, Times New Roman).

The original Jaeger eye chart was developed in 1867 and contained seven paragraphs, each printed in successively smaller font size. The smallest paragraph you could read when holding the chart at approximately 14 inches away determined your near visual acuity.

Typical testing distances for the Snellen chart are 20 feet and 6 meters. If a subject can read a line at 20 feet and the "normal" observer can see the same line at 40 feet, then the subject has 20/40

acuity. Two drawbacks to the Snellen chart are that the chart has a different number of letters per line and the size change of letters is not constant between lines.

Visual Acuity

The Jaeger chart is an eye chart used in testing near vision acuity. It is a card on which paragraphs of text are printed, with the text sizes increasing from 0.37 mm to 2.5 mm. [1] This card is to be read by a patient at a fixed distance from the eye dependent on the J size being read.

In a Snellen eye chart, row's letters of a given size have the corresponding distance number next to them.

Use proper fonts 1. The Snellen chart uses a specific font. When creating the chart, ensure that you use Courier or Courier Bold on your computer. Use the grid of recommended font sizes and distances. The Snellen Chart displays letters of reducing size. As the size is reduced, patients experience blurred vision and vision is impaired.

The Jaeger eye test chart is used for reading up close and for determining your near vision. When reviewing the chart, you will see the notation 1 next to the paragraph with the smallest text. A progressive paragraph of larger text is noted with an increase in the number.

The charts don't necessarily use the latest version of my Snellen font design, which fluctuates. The mood about some of the letters changes. optotype fonts. The optotype requirement is that letters are designed on a 5 × 5 grid, and have constant stroke width. This means that both lower and upper case letters need to share the grid and stroke.
