Instruments not laid before Parliament are included within the Committee's remit; but local instruments and instruments made by devolved administrations are not considered by JCSI unless they are required to be laid before Parliament.

statutory instruments Whether an instrument is subject to parliamentary procedure is determined by the parent Act. Some SIs are not subject to parliamentary procedure and as such are not subject to any parliamentary procedure (other than scrutiny by the Joint Committee on Statutory Instruments) and simply become law on the date stated in them.
