The Lehigh Valley Railroad Company was incorporated in Pennsylvania as the Delaware, Lehigh and Schuylkill and Susquehanna Railroad Company on April 21, 1846, the name being changed on July 1, 1853. It was one of the major anthracite railroads and formed a secondary trunk line between Philadelphia, Pa., New York City, N.J., and Buffalo, N.Y.
