Rhetoric is the art of persuasion. Rhetorical criticism is the study of that art. The rhetorical critic assumes that the final composer of a sermon or literary work has a perspective informed by the culture at that time but also uniquely articulated by that author, and that the author seeks to persuade his/her contemporaries of that perspective.
