In 1996, The American Health Care Association (AHCA), the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO), and the Association of Hospital-Based Skilled Nursing Facilities defined subacute care as: ...comprehensive inpatient care designed for someone with an illness, injury, or exacerbation of a disease process.

Many subacute care programs are clinically and therapeutically comparable to the medical, surgical, and rehabilitation units of an acute care hospital. The cost of care in a subacute care unit is about 40 to 60 percent less than comparable care in an acute care setting.

Subacute care is provided on an inpatient basis for those individuals needing services that are more intensive than those typically received in long-term care nursing facilities but less intensive than acute care.
