The sizes of nuthatches vary, from the large giant nuthatch, at 195 mm (7.7 in) and 36-47 g (1.3-1.7 oz), to the small brown-headed nuthatch and the pygmy nuthatch, both around 100 mm (3.9 in) in length and about 10 g (0.35 oz). Nuthatches are very vocal, using an assortment of whistles, trills and calls.

The blue nuthatch (*Sitta azurea*) is a bird species in the Sittidae family, collectively known as nuthatches. It is a medium-sized nuthatch, measuring 13.5 cm (5.3 in) in length. The species, which lacks sexual dimorphism, has dramatic coloration unlike any other member of its genus. Its head is black or blackish-blue dark blue upper parts close to purple with azure feathers.

These are second in strength only to woodpeckers--with which nuthatches are sometimes confused but to which they aren't even closely related. Both groups can peck on wood, but nuthatch bills are not chisel-shaped and their owners do not have the strong necks and shockproof craniums that protect woodpeckers from concussions.
