Managing Transitions in Early Years. Facilitate visits between Reception and Year 1 children. Organise non-contact time for EYFS and Year 1 staff to discuss individual children and data. Communicate clearly with parents and carers about the transition into Year 1. Plan an open evening to introduce new teachers and explain the structure and routines in Year 1.
